It's earned through a consistently high volume of cases across a broad range of clinical complexity, demonstrated expertise with both straightforward and difficult presentations, proven patient outcomes, and ongoing advanced training in current Invisalign techniques and protocols.

For patients weighing up clear aligner treatment, this accreditation carries real weight: Invisalign at Collins Street Specialist Centre is delivered by specialists whose experience in clear aligner orthodontics is unmatched in the Australian context.

AHPRA Specialist Registration

Every clinician at Collins Street Specialist Centre holds Specialist Registration with the Dental Board of Australia through AHPRA, the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency. The distinction is worth understanding, because it matters in practice.

Specialist Registration is the highest level of dental registration available in Australia. It's a legally defined designation, not a self-applied title, and it carries real requirements: completion of an accredited specialist training programme (a minimum of three to four years of postgraduate study beyond the undergraduate dental degree), examination by the relevant specialist college, ongoing continuing professional development, and adherence to the professional standards set by the Dental Board of Australia.

Patients and referring practitioners can verify specialist registration independently through the AHPRA public register, where all registered specialists can be confirmed by name and specialty.

Specialist college fellowships

The specialists at Collins Street Specialist Centre hold fellowships from Australia's foremost dental specialist colleges. These credentials carry international recognition and represent the highest standard of professional qualification in specialist dentistry:

- **FRACDS** — Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons (across various specialty divisions) - **FRCS** — Fellowship of the Royal College of Surgeons (Edinburgh and other jurisdictions) - **MRACDS** — Membership of the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons

Fellowship is earned through rigorous examination and peer assessment. For referring dentists and patients, these designations provide an independently verified measure of clinical competence and professional standing.

University affiliations
