Clinical expertise

pathology** — diagnosing and managing cysts, lesions, and tumours affecting the mouth and surrounding tissues - **Facial trauma reconstruction** — restoring form and function following injuries to the facial skeleton - **Paediatric maxillofacial surgery** (subspecialty interest) — surgical care tailored to children and adolescents - **Corrective jaw surgery / orthognathic surgery** (subspecialty interest) — repositioning the upper and/or lower jaw to improve bite, function, and facial balance - **TMJ (temporomandibular joint) surgery** (subspecialty interest) — surgical management of the jaw joint when conservative treatments haven't provided enough relief

Dr Kumar has a particular focus on paediatric and complex reconstructive cases, built through highly specialised fellowship training in both Melbourne and the United Kingdom.

Training and qualifications

Dr Kumar's training spans two countries and three institutions. He completed his Bachelor of Health Sciences (BHB) and MBChB in Medicine at the University of Auckland, New Zealand, then went on to complete a Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) at the University of Otago — one of the Southern Hemisphere's foremost dental schools. His specialist surgical training in Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery was completed in Adelaide, culminating in Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons (FRACDS OMS).

The FRACDS (OMS) is the recognised specialist qualification in oral and maxillofacial surgery across Australia and New Zealand, awarded only after a rigorous programme of hospital-based surgical training and formal examination — worth knowing for both patients and referring clinicians.

After his fellowship, Dr Kumar took on two post-fellowship positions in paediatric and reconstructive maxillofacial practice:
