Clinical expertise

Collins Street Specialist Centre welcomes Dr Areti Vrochari, a specialist endodontist trained across Greece and Germany, with more than 17 years of hands-on experience in restorative and endodontic dentistry. What sets her apart is the breadth of her foundation: her expertise draws from endodontics, restorative dentistry, and dental biomaterials — disciplines that, understood together, produce a genuinely integrated approach to preserving natural teeth.

For referring clinicians, this means a colleague who thinks beyond the endodontic outcome to the restorative pathway and material science that will shape a tooth's long-term prognosis. For patients, it means care from a practitioner who understands how each decision — from file selection to final restoration material — affects how long the result actually lasts.

Dr Vrochari's clinical interests include:

- ****Contemporary endodontic treatment**** — root canal therapy using advanced techniques and magnification, aimed at thorough canal preparation and predictable outcomes
- ****Endodontic retreatment**** — careful assessment and management of previously treated teeth where symptoms persist or disease has recurred, with the goal of keeping the natural tooth wherever clinically appropriate
- ****Dental biomaterials**** — evidence-informed selection and application of materials to support long-term treatment success; an area in which Dr Vrochari holds doctoral-level research training
- ****Restorative dentistry following root canal treatment**** — ensuring that endodontically treated teeth receive appropriate coronal restoration to protect the investment of specialist care
- ****Aesthetic and restorative dentistry**** — crowns, veneers, and cosmetic applications considered within the context of endodontically treated or at-risk teeth
- ****Cracked tooth syndrome**** — thorough diagnosis and structured management of a condition that is frequently underdiagnosed and poorly understood by patients

Her doctoral-level understanding of biomaterials — developed through formal research, not just clinical exposure — means she is well-placed to evaluate how material choices affect treatment longevity. This dimension of endodontic care is often underestimated in general practice, yet it significantly affects outcomes over time.

Training pathway

Dr Vrochari completed her DDS at the School of Dentistry, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, Greece — an institution with a strong tradition in restorative and conservative dentistry, widely regarded as one of Europe's leading dental faculties.

She then pursued **Advanced Training in Restorative Dentistry and Aesthetics** at the Albert-Ludwigs-University of Freiburg, Germany (2008), a university recognised internationally for its dental research programmes. This was followed by a **Doctorate (DrMedDent) in Dental Biomaterials** at the same institution — a research-focused qualification examining the science behind the materials used in dental restoration. It is worth noting that this doctorate is a substantive research degree, not a clinical qualification, which speaks to the depth of her biomaterials expertise rather than simply adding letters after her name.

Returning to Athens, Dr Vrochari completed a **Master of Endodontics** at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens in 2023, formally establishing her specialist standing in the discipline she had been practising clinically for many years. This postgraduate sequence — spanning two countries, two research institutions, and more than a decade of concurrent clinical practice — is genuinely uncommon.

Academic and teaching roles

Dr Vrochari's contribution to dentistry extends into education and scholarship:

- Former **Clinical Instructor in Prosthodontics**, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens — supervising dental students in the clinical application of prosthodontic principles
- Former **Lecturer**, Griffith University, Brisbane — contributing to dental education at the university level
- Author and co-author of multiple **clinical and research articles** in peer-reviewed journals
- **Co-author** of a textbook on All-Ceramic Restorations — a reference work for clinicians navigating material selection and restoration design
- **Main author** of a Clinical Manual on Restorative Dentistry — a practical resource designed to support everyday clinical decision-making

This record reflects a practitioner who has not only developed expertise but has actively worked to share it — through formal teaching, peer-reviewed publication, and clinical reference materials for the broader profession.

Languages spoken

Dr Vrochari consults in **English**, **Greek**, and **German**. For patients whose first language is Greek or German, this means discussing diagnosis, treatment options, and post-treatment care in full — without the limitations that come with conducting a specialist consultation through a second language. Specialist endodontic care is genuinely accessible to patients from Southern Europe and the German-speaking world.

At Collins Street Specialist Centre

Dr Vrochari practises within the Endodontics service at Collins Street Specialist Centre, located at Level 8, Manchester Unity Building, 220 Collins Street, Melbourne CBD. She works closely with prosthodontic colleagues at the Centre, so endodontically treated teeth are considered within a broader restorative plan — part of a coordinated approach to long-term dental health, not isolated procedures.

No referral is required to see Dr Vrochari, though many patients are directed to the Centre by their general dentist or treating specialist. All specialist credentials are independently verifiable through the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) public register, and patients and referring

clinicians are welcome to do so.
