Shepparton, Wangaratta, Benalla, Wodonga and Albury all have capable local dental practices. But for patients whose needs go beyond routine care, finding the full range of specialist services close to home isn't always realistic. When a case is genuinely complex — needing coordinated input from multiple registered specialists, advanced diagnostic imaging, or surgical-grade facilities — travelling to Melbourne is often the most clinically sound choice.

Collins Street Specialist Centre (CSSC) brings together all six dental specialties at Level 8, Manchester Unity Building, 220 Collins Street, Melbourne. For patients in north-east Victoria managing complex dental conditions, the trip to Collins Street Specialist Centre offers a standard of coordinated specialist care that's hard to replicate in a regional setting.

The specialist gap in regional north-east Victoria

These aren't rhetorical questions — they reflect the genuine clinical reality that north-east Victorian patients navigate. For many, the answer is CSSC.

The centre engages registered specialists across oral and maxillofacial surgery, orthodontics, endodontics, periodontics, prosthodontics and paediatric dentistry. Patients and referring practitioners can verify specialist registration independently through the AHPRA public register. Under CSSC's peer review model, these specialists collaborate directly on complex cases rather than working in clinical isolation — an arrangement that matters most when a patient's situation spans more than one specialty.

Complex cases that warrant the journey

The drive from Shepparton to Melbourne is roughly two and a half hours. From Wodonga or Albury, it's closer to three. That's a real commitment of time and energy, and it should be made for the right reasons. The cases that bring north-east Victorian patients to CSSC tend to share one characteristic: they require specialist expertise, clinical infrastructure, or multidisciplinary coordination that simply isn't available closer to home.

Those cases include:

- ****Dental implants in challenging situations**** — bone loss requiring grafting before or alongside implant placement, multiple simultaneous placements, full-arch rehabilitation such as All-on-4, and implant failures requiring careful salvage assessment - ****Jaw surgery combined with orthodontics**** — orthognathic surgery for patients with significant skeletal discrepancies or bite problems that orthodontic treatment alone can't resolve - ****Failed or complex root canal treatment**** — specialist endodontic retreatment carried out with microscope-assisted precision to give the tooth the best possible chance - ****Advanced periodontal disease**** — surgical periodontal therapy, regenerative procedures to restore lost bone and tissue, gum grafting for recession, and management of peri-implant infections - ****Full mouth rehabilitation**** — comprehensive reconstruction for patients with widespread decay, significant tooth wear, multiple missing teeth, or previous dental work that hasn't held up - ****Multidisciplinary orthodontics**** — complex adult cases where tooth alignment is planned alongside implant placement, crown work and periodontal treatment, requiring genuine specialist coordination rather than a chain of sequential referrals - ****Paediatric specialist care**** — children with significant dental anxiety, early intervention orthodontic assessment, dental trauma, and developmental dental conditions that need specialist evaluation

Getting to CSSC from north-east Victoria

****From Shepparton:**** Approximately two to two and a half hours by car via the Hume Freeway into the CBD. V/Line operates regular train services from Shepparton to Southern Cross Station.

****From Benalla:**** Around two hours by car. V/Line's north-east line runs regular services through to Southern Cross Station.

****From Wangaratta:**** Approximately two and a half hours by car. V/Line services are available on the north-east line.

****From Wodonga and Albury:**** Around three hours by car via the Hume Freeway. V/Line's north-east line runs directly to Southern Cross Station, making the journey entirely manageable without driving — worth considering if you're attending a surgical or sedation appointment.

From Southern Cross Station, the Manchester Unity Building at 220 Collins Street is a short walk or tram ride along Collins Street. The building sits at the corner of Collins and Swanston Streets, directly above Melbourne Central Station.

How CSSC minimises your travel

CSSC understands that coming from north-east Victoria takes real effort. Where clinically possible, the centre structures appointments to make each visit count, cutting down the total number of trips required.

That means:

- ****Multiple specialist consultations in a single visit**** — you might see a periodontist, prosthodontist and orthodontist within the same Melbourne appointment, rather than making three separate journeys

Once specialist treatment in Melbourne is complete, routine care continues with your trusted local practitioner — check-ups, cleans, simple restorations and the ongoing relationship that underpins good long-term oral health.

CSSC sends detailed treatment reports to your dentist after specialist appointments, so your local clinician stays fully informed and continuity of care is maintained without gaps.

The model is straightforward: specialist treatment in Melbourne when your case calls for it, and local care close to home for everything else.
