Collins Street Specialist Centre: Specialist dental care for the Mornington Peninsula

The Mornington Peninsula is a genuinely nice place to live — good coastline, good food, a relaxed pace. But specialist dental care is one area where living outside the city creates real friction. Residents of Mornington, Frankston, Red Hill, Dromana, Rosebud, Sorrento, Hastings, and Rye regularly find that anything beyond routine dental work means looking further afield.

Collins Street Specialist Centre (CSSC), in Melbourne's CBD, sits within an hour of most parts of the peninsula and brings together a full range of specialist dental services in one building — something that's genuinely hard to find locally.

Close to Melbourne, limited local specialist options

The peninsula is close enough to Melbourne for a day trip, but finding a complete range of dental specialists locally is a different matter. You might track down an orthodontist or a general dentist offering some implant services, but complex cases that need coordinated care across multiple

specialties usually require a broader search.

CSSC has AHPRA-registered specialists in oral and maxillofacial surgery, orthodontics, endodontics, periodontics, prosthodontics, and paediatric dentistry. The centre uses a peer review model where specialists collaborate on complex cases, which means treatment is planned with input from multiple clinicians rather than a single perspective.

When specialist care at CSSC makes sense

Your local dentist on the peninsula is the right choice for check-ups, fillings, and general maintenance. But there are situations where specialist-level care produces meaningfully better outcomes:

- **Dental implants** — particularly when bone grafting, sinus lifts, or immediate loading are involved
- **Adult orthodontics** — Invisalign (Blue Diamond Provider status, over 9,000 cases across the group), ceramic braces, and lingual braces
- **Jaw and bite issues** — orthognathic surgery for underbites, overbites, and jaw asymmetry
- **Root canal retreatment** — when a previous root canal has failed, using dental microscopes and current techniques
- **Gum disease** — periodontal surgery, gum grafting, and regenerative procedures when standard treatment hasn't been enough
- **Full mouth rehabilitation** — coordinated plans combining crowns, bridges, implants, and orthodontics
- **Children's specialist dentistry** — paediatric care for anxious or medically complex children, and management of dental trauma

Getting there

The peninsula's proximity to the CBD makes CSSC a practical option for most residents.

From Frankston: 40–50 minutes by car via the Monash Freeway or EastLink, or take the Frankston train line to Flinders Street and walk from there.

From Mornington: Around 50–60 minutes by car to Collins Street.

From Dromana, Rosebud, and Rye: 60–75 minutes via the Mornington Peninsula Freeway and Monash Freeway.

From Sorrento: Around 75–90 minutes by car.

From Hastings: Approximately 55–65 minutes by car.

CSSC is at Level 8, Manchester Unity Building, 220 Collins Street, on the corner of Collins and Swanston Streets, directly above Melbourne Central Station. Parking is available at the Melbourne Central car park and several nearby options.

Making the most of a single trip

CSSC coordinates appointments so peninsula patients can see multiple specialists in one visit. If your treatment involves an orthodontist, surgeon, and prosthodontist, all three consultations can be scheduled on the same day.

Telehealth follow-ups are available where clinically appropriate. Post-operative reviews, treatment progress checks, and imaging assessments can sometimes be handled remotely, cutting down on return trips to the city.

Your peninsula dentist stays in the loop

CSSC works alongside your local dentist rather than replacing them. Once specialist treatment is complete, your ongoing care continues with your regular provider. CSSC sends through detailed reports and treatment summaries so your dentist knows exactly what was done and what follow-up is needed.

What CSSC brings to the table

With more than 80 clinicians across the group, over 25 AHPRA-registered specialists, CBCT 3D imaging, in-house surgical facilities, and 33 years of experience, the depth of specialist care available at CSSC is hard to match. The peer review process means your case gets looked at from multiple angles before treatment begins.

You can contact CSSC directly to book a consultation. If your local dentist has existing records or imaging, the team is happy to incorporate those into your assessment.
