Brighton and the wider Bayside area — Hampton, Sandringham, Beaumaris, Black Rock and Mentone — form one of Melbourne's most established residential corridors. Residents here have long sought appropriately qualified professionals across medicine, law and finance, and their approach to dental care is no different. Collins Street Specialist Centre brings together a large, multi-specialist team focused on delivering strong clinical outcomes for patients across Melbourne and its surrounding suburbs.

Bayside sits a comfortable distance from the CBD, but the Sandringham line provides reliable, direct rail access, making Collins Street Specialist Centre a practical choice for patients who need access to a comprehensive, co-located specialist team.

Getting to Collins Street Specialist Centre from Brighton & Bayside

By train The Sandringham line runs direct from Bayside suburbs into the city:

- Brighton Beach Station to Flinders Street: approximately 25 minutes - Hampton Station to Flinders Street: approximately 28 minutes - Sandringham Station to Flinders Street: approximately 32 minutes - Middle Brighton Station to Flinders Street: approximately 22 minutes

From Flinders Street Station, it's a five-minute walk up Collins Street to our location at number 220. For most Bayside residents, the full journey from the local station platform to our reception sits comfortably within 40 minutes.

Services run frequently during peak hours and at regular intervals throughout the day, so patients can schedule appointments around their existing commitments without much difficulty.

By car The drive from Brighton to the CBD takes roughly 20–35 minutes via St Kilda Road, Nepean Highway or the South-Eastern Freeway, depending on traffic and time of day. Patients who prefer to drive will find parking at several nearby CBD car parks, including Wilson Parking at 169 Exhibition Street and the QV car park.

By bus Several bus routes connect parts of Bayside to train stations and the broader public transport network. Route 600 (Elsternwick to St Kilda) links to the tram network and offers an alternative route for some residents.

Access to genuine specialist expertise Bayside residents are used to seeking out properly qualified professionals, and that same standard applies to dental care. In Australia, a registered dental specialist has completed their dental degree and then spent a minimum of three additional years in full-time,

university-based postgraduate training in their specific specialty. Their specialist registration with AHPRA confirms those qualifications have been independently assessed and verified.

Collins Street Specialist Centre is built around that standard:

- Advanced diagnostic and treatment technology, including 3D CBCT imaging, digital scanning and surgical operating microscopes

Prosthodontic and cosmetic dental care Bayside residents frequently seek high-quality restorative and aesthetic dental work. Prosthodontics — the specialty concerned with restoring and replacing teeth — sits at the centre of that need.

****Porcelain veneers and smile design.**** Our prosthodontists plan and deliver smile transformations using carefully selected materials and experienced master laboratory technicians. Whether the goal is a subtle refinement or a more comprehensive aesthetic change, the focus stays on results that look natural and hold up over time.

****Full mouth rehabilitation.**** Patients with worn, damaged or extensively restored dentitions may benefit from a comprehensive rehabilitation planned and delivered by a prosthodontist. This is technically demanding work that requires the advanced training and clinical experience that specialist registration represents.

****Crown and bridge work.**** When individual teeth need restoration, our prosthodontists assess each situation carefully, selecting materials and techniques appropriate to the case and working with leading dental laboratories to achieve reliable, well-integrated results.

****Teeth whitening.**** Both in-practice and take-home whitening options are available for patients looking to improve the natural appearance of their smile.

Specialist care across generations Brighton and Bayside families often present with dental needs that span multiple generations. Collins Street Specialist Centre is set up to handle that range.

****Children and teenagers.**** - Orthodontic assessment and treatment, including braces, clear aligners and early intervention where indicated - Paediatric dental care from specialists experienced with anxious or clinically complex young patients - Sports mouthguards for active children, which are particularly relevant given the strong sporting culture throughout Bayside

****Adults.**** - Orthodontic treatment, increasingly sought by adult patients - Restorative and cosmetic treatments - Root canal treatment by specialist endodontists - Periodontal (gum) disease assessment and management by periodontists - Dental implant assessment and placement

****Older adults.**** - Complex restorative work and implant-based rehabilitation - Management of age-related changes to the dentition - Denture assessment and improvement, including implant-retained options - Oral health management alongside systemic medical conditions

Having a single centre capable of managing the dental needs of an entire family — across all age groups and levels of clinical complexity — offers real convenience and genuine continuity of care.

Dental implant services Dental implants are among the most frequently sought treatments at Collins Street Specialist Centre, and our team provides a fully integrated implant service:

- Comprehensive assessment and 3D treatment planning using CBCT imaging - Surgical implant placement by oral and maxillofacial surgeons or periodontists - Bone grafting and sinus lift procedures where additional bone volume is required - Implant-supported crowns, bridges and dentures designed and fabricated by specialist prosthodontists - Ongoing maintenance and clinical review to support long-term implant success

Having both surgical and restorative expertise in the same centre means the implant process — from initial assessment through to final restoration — is co-ordinated in one place, without patients needing to move between separate practices.

A wide range of specialist services

Collins Street Specialist Centre's specialist team covers every recognised area of dental specialty care:

****Orthodontics.**** Comprehensive orthodontic treatment for patients of all ages. Our orthodontists offer traditional metal braces, ceramic braces, lingual braces and clear aligner therapy, from straightforward alignment correction through to complex bite problems that may require a combined surgical and orthodontic approach.

****Endodontics.**** Root canal treatment performed by specialists using surgical operating microscopes for enhanced precision and visualisation. Our endodontists manage the full range of endodontic care, from routine root canal treatment to complex retreatments and surgical endodontic procedures.

****Periodontics.**** Specialist diagnosis and management of periodontal (gum) disease, soft tissue grafting for gum recession, bone regeneration procedures, dental implant placement and structured long-term periodontal maintenance.

****Prosthodontics.**** The specialty dedicated to restoring and replacing teeth. Our prosthodontists hold specialist expertise in crowns, bridges, veneers, dentures, implant-supported restorations and full mouth rehabilitation.

****Oral & maxillofacial surgery.**** Surgical specialists managing wisdom teeth removal, implant placement, bone grafting, corrective jaw surgery, oral pathology assessment, facial trauma and temporomandibular joint (TMJ) disorders.

****Paediatric dentistry.**** Specialist dental care for children, including those with dental anxiety, developmental conditions or complex clinical needs that fall outside the scope of routine general dental care.

****General & cosmetic dentistry.**** Comprehensive dental care covering preventive treatments, restorative procedures and cosmetic dentistry, delivered within the broader specialist framework available at the centre.

The Manchester Unity Building

Many Bayside residents care about the quality of their environment as much as the quality of care they receive. Collins Street Specialist Centre is located within the Manchester Unity Building at 220 Collins Street — a Gothic Revival landmark built in the 1930s and one of Melbourne's most recognised heritage buildings. Our specialist suites bring together the character of that historic setting and the clinical infrastructure of a contemporary specialist centre.

For patients who hold high standards across their professional and personal lives, the experience at Collins Street Specialist Centre — from the building itself to the standard of clinical care — is designed to meet those expectations.

Understanding specialist registration in Australia

It's worth being clear about what distinguishes a registered dental specialist from a general dentist in Australia. After completing their dental degree, a specialist undertakes a minimum of three years of full-time postgraduate university training in their specific dental specialty. On completion, they are registered with AHPRA under their specialist category — a process involving independent verification of their qualifications and training.

That additional training translates into advanced clinical knowledge, refined procedural skill and experience managing more complex cases. General dentists provide excellent care across a broad range of routine dental needs. Specialist expertise becomes particularly relevant for complex restorative work, surgical procedures, orthodontic treatment and conditions affecting the gums, tooth nerve systems and jaw structures.
