Collins Street Specialist Centre — Specialist Dental Care for East Melbourne & Fitzroy

East Melbourne and Fitzroy are two of the suburbs closest to Collins Street Specialist Centre — close enough that many residents simply walk to their appointments. CSSC serves these established inner-city communities with comprehensive specialist dental care in a single, well-located centre. Whether you're in the heritage streetscapes of East Melbourne or the busy, eclectic precinct of Fitzroy, getting to specialist-level dental care is genuinely straightforward.

Getting to CSSC from East Melbourne & Fitzroy

East Melbourne — walking distance

East Melbourne borders the CBD directly, and much of the suburb sits within a 10–15 minute walk of our Collins Street location. Many patients find the route through the Treasury Gardens, or along Wellington Parade into Collins Street, a relaxed way to arrive for an appointment.

For those who prefer public transport:

- Tram routes 48 and 75 run along Wellington Parade and into the city centre - Jolimont Station (on the Hurstbridge and Mernda lines) provides a short connection to Flinders Street or directly into the city grid
- Driving is straightforward, with the MCG car parks and various CBD parking options available nearby

Fitzroy

Fitzroy sits immediately north of the CBD and is well connected by several tram routes:

- Route 11 (West Preston to Docklands) runs along Brunswick Street through Fitzroy and into the city
- Route 86 (Bundoora to Docklands) runs along Smith Street through Collingwood and Fitzroy, connecting to the CBD
- Route 96 (East Brunswick to St Kilda) travels along Nicholson Street on Fitzroy's western edge

The tram from Fitzroy to Collins Street typically takes 10–15 minutes. Cycling is also a practical option — Fitzroy's relatively flat terrain makes for a manageable ride into the CBD.

Why East Melbourne & Fitzroy residents choose CSSC

East Melbourne — established families and professionals

East Melbourne has long been one of Melbourne's most established residential suburbs. Its population includes long-term families, medical professionals drawn by the proximity to several major hospitals,

and people working across the CBD and surrounding precincts.

Residents of East Melbourne commonly seek:

- Comprehensive specialist care for the whole family, coordinated across disciplines within a single centre
- High-quality restorative work — crowns, veneers and smile rehabilitation delivered by experienced prosthodontists
- Orthodontic assessment and treatment for children and teenagers at the clinically recommended stages
- Implant solutions for missing teeth, with the practical advantage of a specialist centre that manages both the surgical and restorative phases
- Periodontal care to support long-term gum health

The proximity to several of Melbourne's major hospitals — including the Epworth, St Vincent's and the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre — also means Collins Street Specialist Centre regularly receives referrals for dental assessment connected to medical treatment. This includes pre-surgical dental clearance, management of dental complications arising from chemotherapy or radiation therapy, and complex prosthodontic rehabilitation following oncological care.

Fitzroy — a diverse community with varied clinical needs

Fitzroy is home to a broad cross-section of Melbourne residents: creatives, professionals, students and long-established community members. That diversity is reflected in the range of specialist dental presentations we see from Fitzroy patients:

- Cosmetic dentistry and smile design — Fitzroy residents often bring a considered aesthetic perspective to treatment discussions, and appreciate the clinical precision involved in veneers, composite bonding and comprehensive smile rehabilitation
- Orthodontics for adults — clear aligner therapy and discreet fixed orthodontic options are consistently in demand amongst working adults seeking treatment that fits around professional life
- Emergency dental care — dental trauma can come from an active lifestyle, and being close to a specialist centre with oral and maxillofacial surgeons on staff is a real practical advantage
- Wisdom teeth assessment and removal — many younger Fitzroy residents fall within the age group most commonly affected by third molar complications
- Preventive and restorative care supported by specialist expertise where indicated

Heritage areas — long-term residents and evolving dental needs

Both East Melbourne and Fitzroy have significant heritage housing stock and well-established communities. Many residents have lived in these suburbs for decades, and their dental needs change accordingly:

- Managing age-related dental changes — tooth wear, gum recession and older restorations that need updating or replacement
- Denture and implant solutions for missing teeth, with an emphasis on restoring both function and appearance
- Periodontal maintenance to preserve long-term gum health and support existing restorations
- Complex restorative planning that accounts for years of dental history and takes a staged, considered approach

Our prosthodontists at Collins Street Specialist Centre have extensive experience developing long-term treatment plans that respond to changing clinical needs over time — an approach that suits patients with complex or evolving presentations particularly well.

Specialist services available at Collins Street Specialist Centre

Collins Street Specialist Centre offers every recognised dental specialty under one roof, so residents of East Melbourne and Fitzroy can access the full scope of specialist care without travelling to multiple locations.

****Orthodontics**** covers braces and aligner therapy for patients of all ages, from early interceptive treatment in children to comprehensive adult orthodontics. Our orthodontists assess and manage crowding, spacing, overbites, underbites, crossbites and skeletal discrepancies.

****Endodontics**** is root canal treatment performed by specialist endodontists using surgical-grade microscopes for precision and optimal outcomes. When a tooth's pulp is compromised by infection or trauma, specialist endodontic care gives the best clinical opportunity to retain the natural tooth.

****Periodontics**** covers diagnosis and treatment of gum disease, gum grafting, regenerative periodontal procedures, implant placement and ongoing periodontal maintenance. Periodontal disease is highly prevalent and often under-recognised; specialist assessment can make a significant difference to long-term outcomes.

****Prosthodontics**** ranges from a single crown to full-mouth rehabilitation. Our prosthodontists specialise in restoring damaged, worn or missing teeth to full function and natural aesthetics — the dental specialty most directly concerned with the long-term integrity of the restored dentition.

****Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery**** covers wisdom teeth removal, implant surgery, corrective jaw surgery, management of oral pathology, trauma and temporomandibular joint (TMJ) disorders, all managed by university-trained surgical specialists with formal postgraduate qualifications.

****Paediatric Dentistry**** is specialist dental care for children and adolescents, delivered by clinicians with specific training in child development, behaviour management and the clinical needs of young patients from toddlerhood through the teenage years.

****General & Cosmetic Dentistry**** covers routine examinations, preventive treatments, restorations, tooth whitening and aesthetic enhancements, all delivered within a specialist-supported environment.

When considering any specialist dental treatment, patients can verify their treating clinician's specialist registration through the [Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA)](<https://www.ahpra.gov.au>), which maintains the public register of all registered health practitioners in Australia.
