****Prosthodontics**** - crowns, bridges, dentures, porcelain veneers, full mouth rehabilitation, and implant-supported restorations - ****Paediatric dentistry**** - specialist care for children with dental anxiety, complex decay, dental trauma, and developmental concerns

Having all of these under one roof matters not just for convenience, but for the quality of care you actually receive.

The peer review advantage

At CSSC, complex cases aren't handed to a single specialist working in isolation. Specialists from different disciplines collaborate directly on your treatment plan.

Consider a patient who needs a dental implant but also has gum disease and a bite problem. The usual path means visiting a periodontist in one place, an orthodontist somewhere else, and a prosthodontist in a third location, each forming their own plan without much awareness of what the others are doing. That leads to longer treatment, more appointments, and care that doesn't always fit together cleanly.

At CSSC, those three specialists work together. They share your CBCT 3D imaging, agree on the sequencing and timing of each phase, and produce one coordinated plan.

Your local dentist may offer some specialised services

Many general dentists in regional Victoria have completed further training in areas like implants or orthodontics, and that additional training is genuinely useful for straightforward cases.

But there's a real difference between a general dentist with extra training and an AHPRA-registered specialist. Specialists complete an additional three to five years of full-time university training beyond their dental degree, focused entirely on their specialty, and they're registered with AHPRA specifically in that role.

For cases involving multiple teeth, bone loss, bite issues, jaw discrepancies, or treatments that haven't worked elsewhere, a registered specialist can make a meaningful difference to the outcome.

No referral required

Many people assume they need a referral from their local dentist before seeing a specialist. At CSSC, you don't. You can call directly, describe what's going on, and book a consultation.

Plenty of patients find CSSC through their own research — reading about their condition, looking into treatment options, and deciding they want a specialist's assessment. That's a completely normal way to arrive, and the team is used to it.

If your local dentist does provide a referral, that's useful too. CSSC works with referring dentists across Victoria and is happy to share findings and treatment updates with your regular practitioner.

Worth the journey

Getting to Collins Street is easier than most regional patients expect. The Manchester Unity Building sits at the corner of Collins and Swanston Streets, directly above Melbourne Central Station. Whether you're driving, catching V/Line, or taking the train, you'll end up at an Art Deco building right in the centre of the CBD.

For regional patients, CSSC tries to consolidate appointments so you can see multiple specialists in a single visit. If your treatment involves both an orthodontist and a surgeon, the centre can schedule both consultations on the same day, cutting down on trips to Melbourne.
