If you live in Ballarat, Bacchus Marsh, Melton, Daylesford, Creswick, Ararat or Maryborough and need specialist dental treatment, Melbourne is closer than you think. Collins Street Specialist Centre (CSSC) is around 90 minutes by car or V/Line train from Ballarat, and offers all six dental specialties under one roof at Level 8, Manchester Unity Building, 220 Collins Street.

Why Patients from Western Victoria Choose CSSC

Ballarat and the surrounding region have excellent general dentists. But when your dental problem goes beyond routine care - when you need jaw surgery, complex orthodontics, dental implants, root canal retreatment or a full mouth rehabilitation - finding a registered specialist locally can be difficult.

Some regional areas have visiting specialists who attend once a week or once a fortnight. While that can work for straightforward cases, complex treatment often requires a team of specialists working together, access to advanced imaging like CBCT 3D scanning, and the ability to coordinate multiple phases of treatment.

CSSC engages AHPRA-registered specialists in oral and maxillofacial surgery, orthodontics, endodontics, periodontics, prosthodontics and paediatric dentistry. With all six specialties in one location, you get a level of collaborative care that simply is not available in most regional centres.

The Kinds of Cases Worth Travelling For

Not every dental problem needs a specialist in Melbourne. Your local dentist in Ballarat, Bacchus Marsh or Melton handles most dental needs brilliantly. But certain cases genuinely benefit from specialist-level, multidisciplinary care:

- **Dental implants** where bone grafting or a sinus lift is required before placement
- **Jaw surgery** (orthognathic surgery) for severe underbites, overbites or jaw discrepancies
- **Complex orthodontics** in adults who also need implants, crowns or gum treatment
- **Failed root canal treatment** requiring retreatment under a dental microscope by an endodontic specialist
- **Full mouth rehabilitation** combining crowns, implants, bridges and possibly orthodontics
- **Children with dental anxiety** or complex dental needs who require a paediatric dentist experienced in managing fearful young patients
- **Gum disease** that has progressed beyond what general treatment can manage, requiring specialist periodontal surgery

These are the cases where the 90-minute drive to Collins Street pays for itself in better outcomes and fewer complications.

Getting to CSSC from Ballarat and Western Victoria

****By car:**** Take the Western Freeway (M8) from Ballarat to the West Gate Freeway, then into the CBD. The journey takes around 90 minutes depending on traffic. Parking is available at several car parks near Collins Street, including Melbourne Central and QV.

****By train:**** V/Line runs regular services from Ballarat to Southern Cross Station. From Southern Cross, it is a short tram ride or 15-minute walk along Collins Street to the Manchester Unity Building at the corner of Collins and Swanston Streets.

****From Bacchus Marsh and Melton:**** Even closer to Melbourne, typically 45-60 minutes by car or train.

****From Daylesford, Creswick, Ararat and Maryborough:**** Allow two to two and a half hours by car. For cases requiring multiple visits, CSSC works to consolidate appointments and offers telehealth follow-ups where clinically appropriate to reduce the number of trips.

We Work With Your Local Dentist

Coming to CSSC does not mean leaving your local dentist behind. After specialist treatment, your ongoing general dental care continues with your trusted dentist in your home town. CSSC provides detailed reports and treatment summaries to your local dentist, ensuring continuity of care.

Many patients find it reassuring to know that their specialist treatment is handled by a dedicated team in Melbourne, while their routine check-ups, cleans and general care continue locally with someone who knows them and their dental history.

No Referral Required

You do not need a referral to see any specialist at CSSC. Many patients from Ballarat and western Victoria find CSSC through their own research, and contact us directly. If your local dentist has provided imaging or records, we are happy to incorporate them.
