Living on the Mornington Peninsula means beautiful coastline, great food and a relaxed lifestyle. But when it comes to specialist dental care, options can be limited. Patients in Mornington, Frankston, Red Hill, Dromana, Rosebud, Sorrento, Hastings and Rye often find that complex dental problems require a trip beyond their local area.

Collins Street Specialist Centre (CSSC) in the Melbourne CBD is under an hour from most of the peninsula. With all six dental specialties at one address, it offers the kind of comprehensive specialist care that is difficult to find locally.

Close to Melbourne, Limited Specialist Access

The Mornington Peninsula is close enough to Melbourne for a comfortable day trip, yet many residents have found that accessing the full range of dental specialists locally is not always straightforward. You might find an orthodontist, and your general dentist may offer some implant work, but what about complex cases that need coordinated care across multiple specialties?

CSSC engages AHPRA-registered specialists in oral and maxillofacial surgery, orthodontics, endodontics, periodontics, prosthodontics and paediatric dentistry. The centre operates a peer review model where these specialists collaborate on complex cases, resulting in better planned, better coordinated treatment.

When to Consider Specialist Care at CSSC

Your local peninsula dentist is the right person for regular check-ups, fillings and routine care. But specialist-level treatment makes a real difference for:

- **Dental implants** - especially when bone grafting, sinus lifts or immediate loading are involved
- **Adult orthodontics** - Invisalign (Blue Diamond Provider status, 9,000+ cases across the group), ceramic braces, lingual braces
- **Jaw and bite problems** - orthognathic surgery for underbites, overbites and jaw asymmetry
- **Complex root canal cases** - retreatment of failed root canals using dental microscopes and advanced techniques
- **Gum disease treatment** - periodontal surgery, gum grafting and regenerative procedures when standard treatment has not been enough
- **Full mouth restoration** - comprehensive plans combining crowns, bridges, implants and orthodontics
- **Children's specialist dentistry** - paediatric dental care for anxious or medically complex children, dental trauma management

Getting There

The Mornington Peninsula's proximity to the Melbourne CBD makes CSSC a practical option:

****From Frankston:**** 40-50 minutes by car via the Monash Freeway or EastLink. Frankston train line to Flinders Street, then a short walk.

****From Mornington:**** Approximately 50-60 minutes by car to Collins Street.

****From Dromana, Rosebud and Rye:**** Around 60-75 minutes by car via the Mornington Peninsula Freeway and Monash Freeway.

****From Sorrento:**** Approximately 75-90 minutes by car.

****From Hastings:**** Around 55-65 minutes by car.

CSSC is located at Level 8, Manchester Unity Building, 220 Collins Street - at the corner of Collins and Swanston Streets, directly above Melbourne Central Station. Parking is available at Melbourne Central car park and several nearby options.

Consolidating Your Visits

CSSC coordinates appointments so peninsula patients can see multiple specialists in a single visit. If your treatment involves an orthodontist, a surgeon and a prosthodontist, all three consultations can be arranged on the same day.

The centre also offers telehealth follow-ups where clinically appropriate. Post-operative reviews, treatment progress discussions and imaging reviews can sometimes be handled virtually, saving you a trip to the city.

Your Peninsula Dentist Continues Your Care

CSSC does not replace your local dentist - it complements them. After specialist treatment, your routine dental care continues with your trusted peninsula practitioner. CSSC sends detailed reports and treatment summaries, keeping your dentist fully informed about what was done and what ongoing care is needed.
